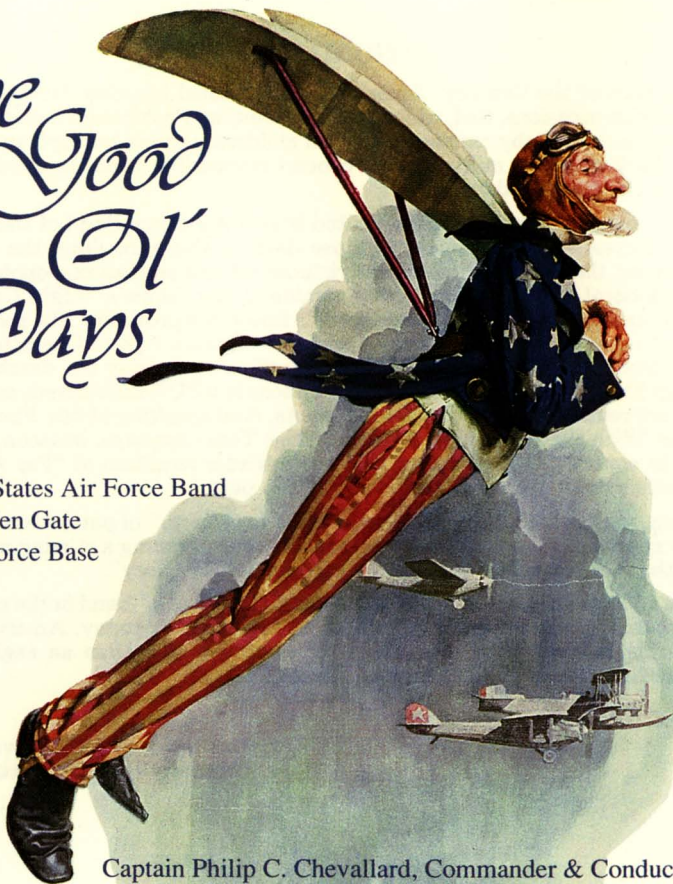


# The Good Ol' Days

Listen to the stirring strains of von Suppe's "Light Cavalry" Overture, and a trilogy of Leroy Anderson's finest compositions. The soloists, too, are most noteworthy. MSgt Daisy Jackson's "Golden Age of Operetta" recaptures the tradition of Jenny Lind. "Fluffy Ruffles", featuring the dazzling talents of SSgt Fred Brunz, proves that the xylophone is a FUN instrument, especially when we are reminded of its "vaudeville" roots. And speaking of fun, Fucik's "The Old Bear With the Sore Tail", featuring TSgt Tom Chaparas, bassoon, is filled with it! In contrast, TSgt Carolyn de Kock's tender rendition of "Far Away Places" reminds us of the great balladeers of the past.

Then, to round it all out, an intense "shot in the arm" of patriotism as we present our special guest artist, Miss Constance Towers, reading a stirring personification of the American flag entitled "My Name is Old Glory".

It's all here—the variety, the excitement, the joy of a "band in the park" concert, updated to make it as fresh and as all-American as today. America! Its colors shining brighter than ever; its pride soaring higher than an eagle. Indeed, in countless ways, THESE are the Good Ol' Days!
