

JAY ROZEN: Educated at Ithaca College, Yale University and University of North Texas, tubist, composer, improvisor Jay Rozen has had a diverse career. From 1978-80 he was the tubist with the Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra. During his "Texas years" (1984-1999) Rozen played with the Creative Opportunity Orchestra, The Capitol of Texas Brass Quintet, the Austim Klezmorim and the European Tuba Quartet. Since moving to New York in 1999, Jay has performed with Anthony Braxton, the Orchestra of the SEM Ensemble, the Low Frequency Tuba Band, The Da Lontano Brass Quintet and Underground Brass. He has performed with jazz greats Ray Anderson, Burton Greene, Perry Robinson, Wadada Leo Smith, Hamiett Bluiett and Charli Persip. Jay has toured and recorded extensively with Anthony Braxton. He can be heard on several of his CDs, including the groundbreaking 9 CD/1 DVD set 9 COMPOSITIONS (Firehouse Records #12). A champion of new music, Rozen has had works written for him by many composers, including Virgil Thomson, David Lang and a concerto by novelist/composer Anthony Burgess.
