Det starkt dramatiska draget i Kraus' orkestermusik skiljer honom från samtida symfoniker och förlänar honom den unika *Sturm und Drang*-titeln: "Original-Genie". De fem orkesterverk som här presenteras komponerades under åren 1781–1792, med andra ord både före och efter tonsättarens stora Europaresa.

*The strongly dramatic character of Kraus' orchestral music distinguishes him from his contemporaries and allows his position to be described by that unique *Sturm und Drang* rubric: "Original-Genie". The five orchestral compositions presented here were composed during the years 1781–1792, before and after his grand tour in Europe.*
